1. Mail a ***handwritten personal note*** (a postcard stamp is only \$.37) to those on your "125 lists" inviting them to *join you* by running as a write-in candidate. Nomination Papers may be downloaded off of the County Recorder's website and must be turned in by May 20.
2. Follow up with a *brief telephone call* offering to assist in turning in their Nomination Paper by May 20.
