The Tellers Report for the 2022 Mandatory meeting of the Maricopa County Republican Committee (MCRC) is presented encompassing the original canvas of election results from the day of the event (January 8, 2022) and the results of the Re-Count conducted on January 29, 2022.

- I. Observations
 - A. Significant Undervotes were observed for all three rounds of voting
 - B. Bylaw Amendments require a 2/3 vote to pass. The number of undervotes for the Bylaw Amendments significantly affected the outcome depending on which method of calculation was used.
 - C. Consequently, Chair Niland elected to conduct a Re-Count of the ballots to determine if the very high number of undervotes (~20% vs. typical number of 3 – 5%) was real or due to some error with the ballot scanning.

Announcement of Results of Vote on Proposed Bylaw Amendments

The Chairman explained that two-thirds affirmative vote is required to adopt bylaw amendments. With 1,225 votes cast, two-thirds or 817 were required for adoption of an amendment. The vote totals received by each proposed amendment were:

Proposed Bylaw Amendment #1	838 Passed
Proposed Bylaw Amendment #2	713 Failed
Proposed Bylaw Amendment #3	604 Failed

From Notes by Raymond Jones:

Total Ballots cast: 1225

Bylaw Proposal 1: 838 Aye / 303 Nay (PASSED) $838 + 303 = 1141$

Bylaw Proposal 2: 713 Aye / 428 Nay (FAILED) $713 + 428 = 1141$ (2/3 of 1141 = 760, not 817)

Bylaw Proposal 3: 604 Aye / 533 Nay (FAILED) $604 + 533 = 1137$ (2/3 of 1137 = 757, not 817)

This is the only election in the past SEVEN years that has calculated the pass/fail for bylaws or resolutions using the TOTAL Ballot Count in place of the SUM of the YESs and NOs. Note that in this case, it would not have made a difference!

CONCLUSION:

Using the TOTAL Ballot Count in the denominator for calculating the percent Pass or Fail effectively transforms the neutral “abstention” or “undervote” into a “NO” vote. This is why Robert’s Rules of Order prefers that any undervotes (along with overvotes) be discarded from the calculation.

It is recommended that for the MCRC 2022 Mandatory Meeting, we follow our overwhelming past practice of interpreting our bylaws, consistent with Robert’s Rules of Order and calculate the Pass/Fail of both our Bylaw Amendments and Resolutions as the percent of votes CAST by the members voting on each question, not including undervotes or overvotes.

To prevent confusion in the future about how to determine the outcome of bylaw amendments and resolutions voted on by the body, here is a proposal for revising the language in our bylaws to make it crystal clear and consistent with the language used in Robert's Rules of Order.

Proposed Change in language of bylaws:

Article X, Section 1: These Bylaws may be amended at MCRC meetings by a two-third (2/3) vote of members, present in person or by proxy,...

Change to: ...by a two-third (2/3) vote of votes cast by members, present in person or by proxy...
